### Cebu, Philippines

With a focus on sustainability, Lexmark Cebu participated in an annual mangrove planting and coastal clean-up event in partnership with DENR-CENRO.



In 2016, Lexmark partnered with [JCI Cebu Inc.](#) for a Light Up Cebu event, which brought solar lighting to 16 homes and organized planting of 100 tree seedlings.
